

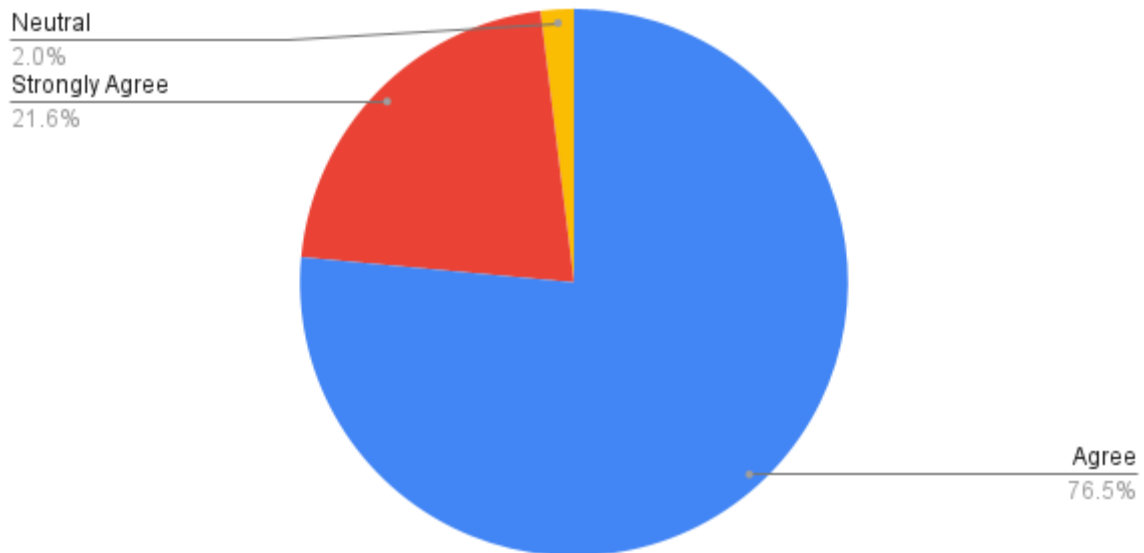


FACULTY FEEDBACK REPORT 2022-2023

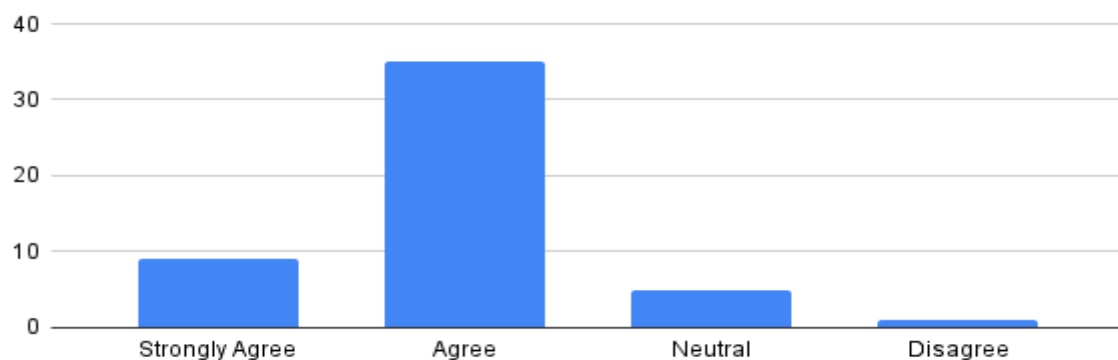

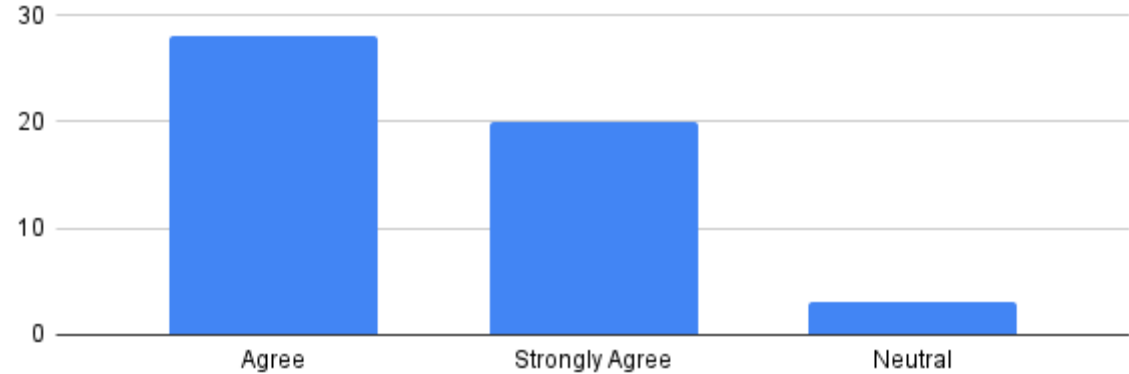
1. The College encourages participatory decision making by involving employees at various levels



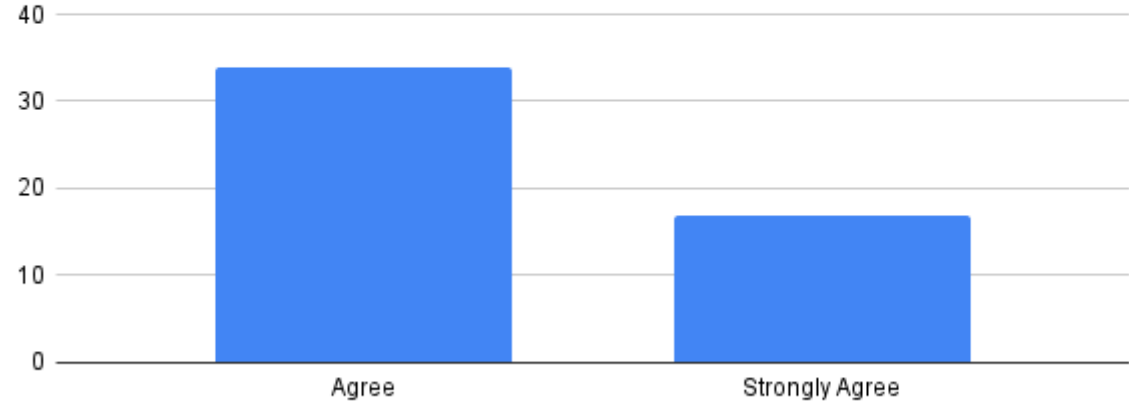
2. The College encourages faculty members to participate in designing and developing the course curriculum at university level



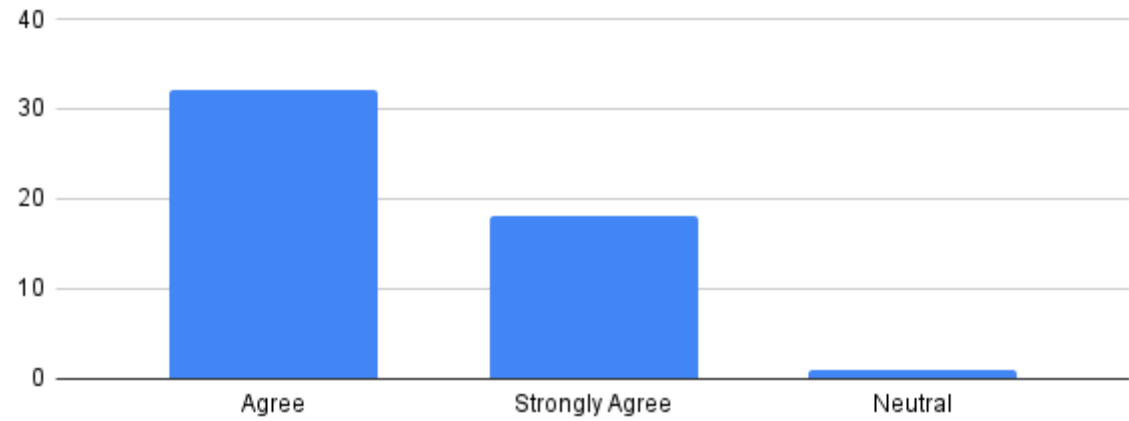
3. Faculty members have the freedom to adopt new techniques/ strategies of teaching such as group discussion, seminar presentation etc.



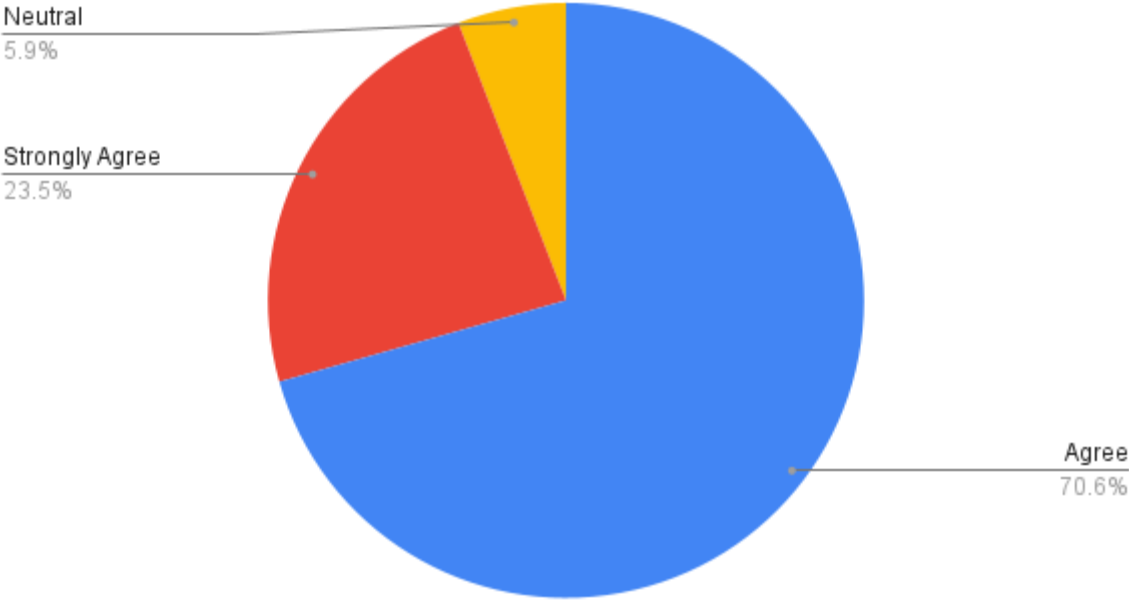
4. College encourages faculty members to invite experts from academia, research institutions and industry in workshops/ seminar etc. organized by the respective departments



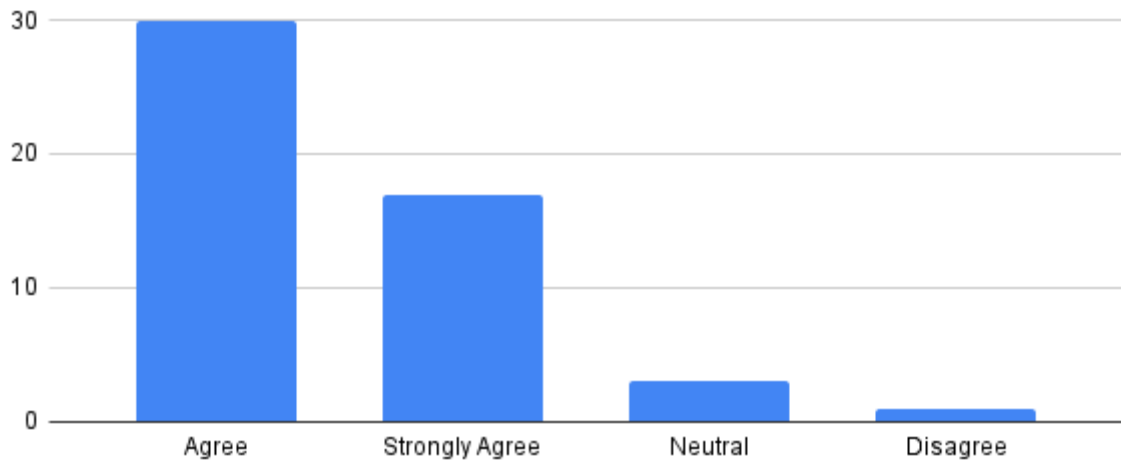
5. The Examination and Evaluation system followed by the college is effective and fair in judging students academic performance



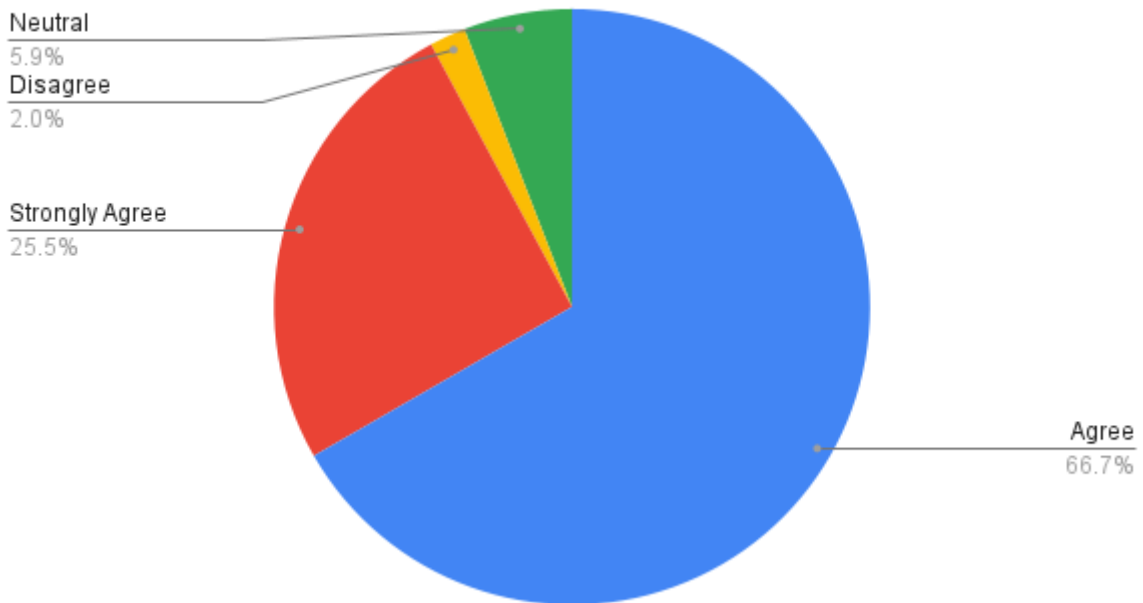
6. The library is optimally used by the faculty and students.



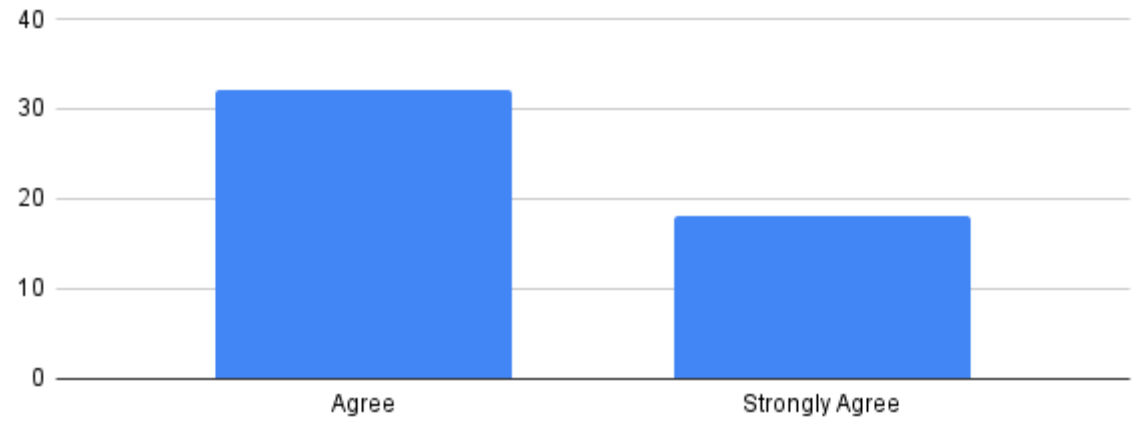
7. The college website is updated and well maintained



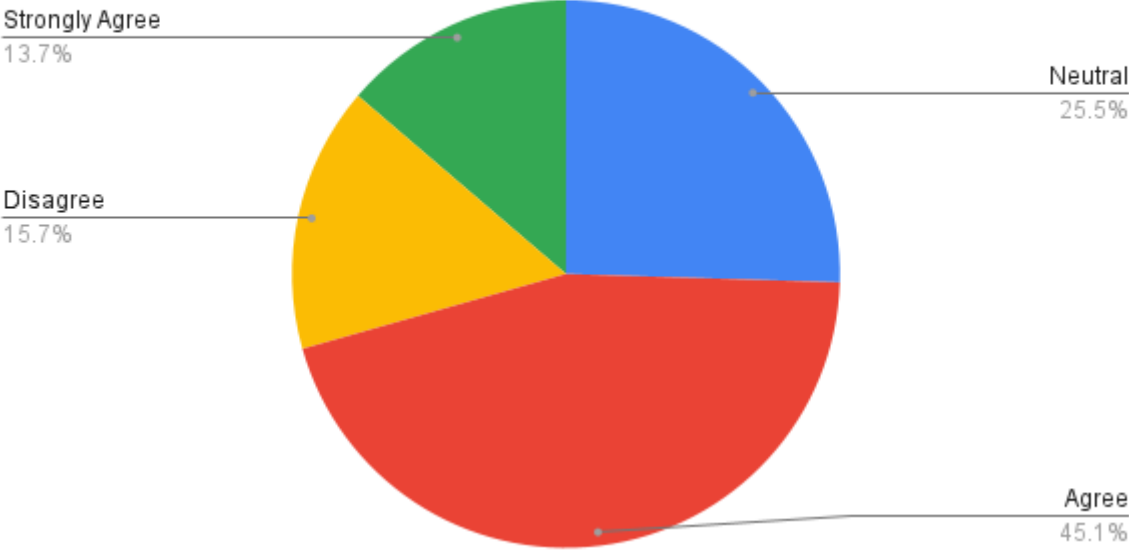
8. The College has taken initiatives to encourage research



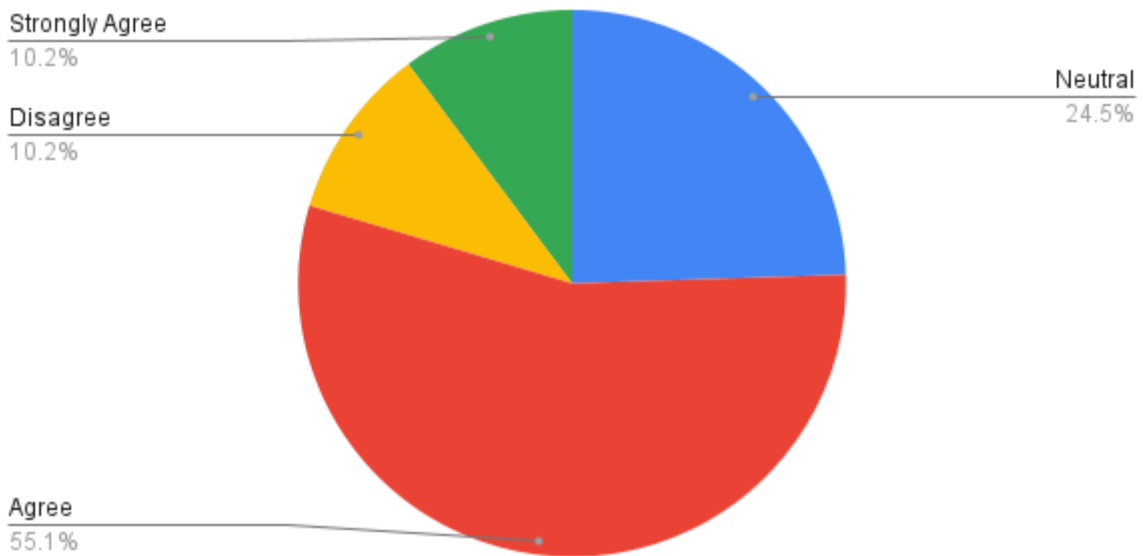
9. The college supports the participation of faculty in national conference/ seminars/symposium by providing academic leave



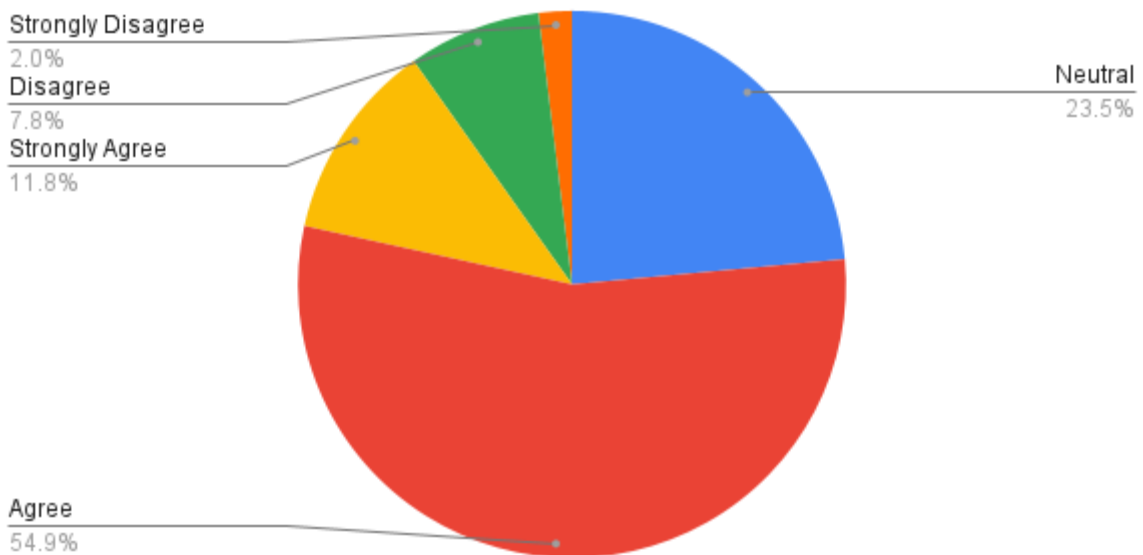
10. ICT facilities available to the faculty available in the college are sufficient and adequate



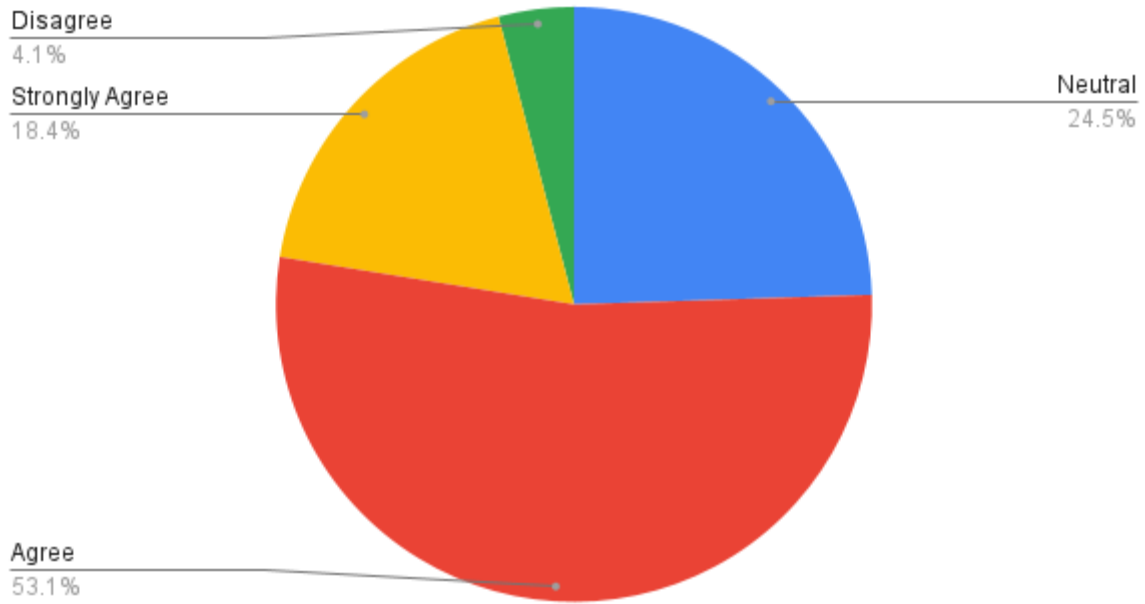
11. The Labs are adequately equipped for hands-on training of students (if applicable) and research



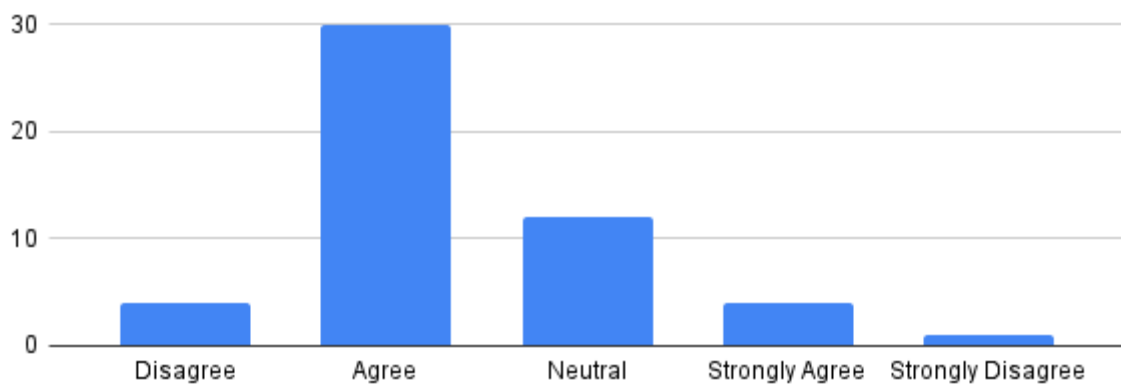
12. The College provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty for their economic growth



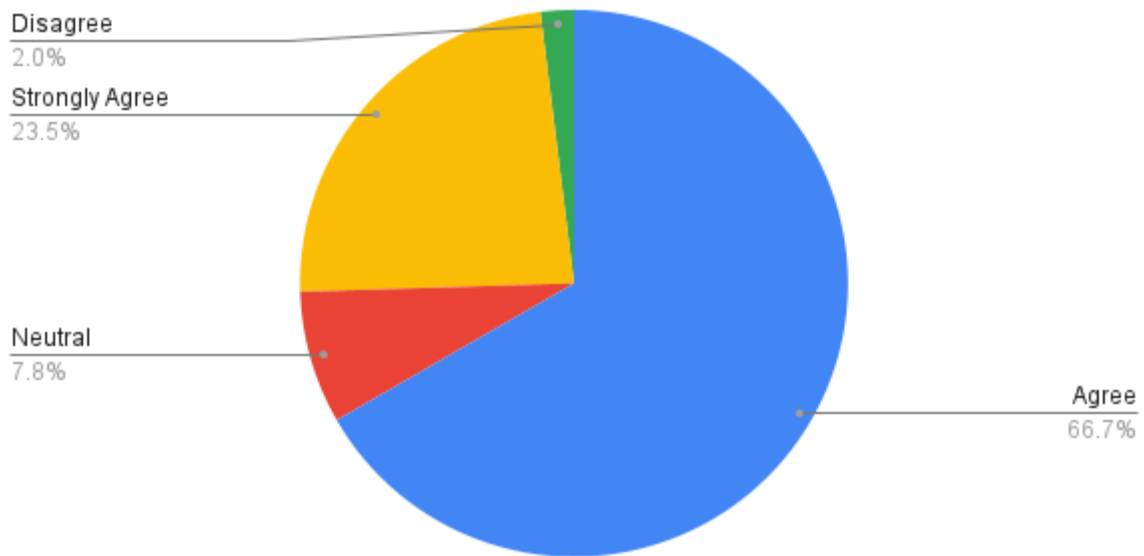
13. The College has an effective grievance redressal system

SUMMARY OF THE FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:

1. More than 60% faculty members (strongly) agree that the college provide adequate opportunities and facilities for the economic growth of teachers.
2. Only 4% of the faculty members opined that grievance redrassal system is ineffective.
3. Less than 10 teachers disagree the books mentioned in the syllabus are available in the library.
4. Around 80% of the teachers agree that faculty orientation programme on the introduction of the NEP-2020.
5. Almost all the teachers agree that the evaluation process followed by the college is fair and effective.
6. 15% of the teacher opined that ICT facilities available in the college are not sufficient.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT OF THE TEACHERS FEEDBACK:

On the basis of teachers feedback it is decided to develop ICT Classrooms in the College within short period of time.
