#### **Department of Bodo**

Programme outcome :- After completion of this programme the students with obtaining more information about the history of bodo literature, ancient social law, folk customs, ritual, religion, political, culture and traditional of the bodo society. It will make the students well educated in the bodo language and every side of the society.

Programme Specific Outcome:- This programme provides skill in creative writing ang competence in the language will empower them with communicative skill. After the passing undergraduate the students can admission for the post graduate in literature, Linguistics, culture studies act. Then they can engage themselves as teachers and also a entrepreneurs in various side.

Course Outcome:- After completion of the course in Bodo at undergraduate level develop students with the knowledge of linguistics and the history of Bodo literature including Western and Eastern Literature, culture. The history of the bodo literature, Bodo folk culture, social folk customs of the Bodos paper require knowledge. Different prose, poetry, drama, criticism of the writers and their creation and comparative literature with other ethnic language are also main topics covered in the syllabus.

#### DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

Programme Outcome (P. O.):

#### B.A Education Major& General

The Under Graduate programme in Education Major helps the students to understand the meaning, aims, function and role of Education. They are able to employ critical thinking and efficiency in problems solving ability in Education. The course explains the Indian and Western schools of Philosophy and their impact on Education. It discusses the contribution of great educators. The students after completing course at Graduation level in Education will develop an understanding of major concepts, theoretical principles in Education. The recommendations of the different Education Commissions are also included in the syllabus. By analyzing the various problems faced by the mentally and physically challenged children, an awareness program can be designed to encounter the problems of challenged children. Micro-teaching, preparing lesson- plans, practice teaching in schools which are integral parts of the syllabus will train the students in teaching skills. Students will also gain a reasonable knowledge in psychology. On successful completion of the course the students become efficient for teaching activities and guiding others to become good citizens in the society by usage of value education.

# DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

# Programme outcome:

The programme basically deals with past events written in a chronological account and relating to the present. Sound knowledge of different Historical periods in each semester is studied with a definite emphasis on modern research and trends. The major course mainly comprises of Ancient, Medieval and Modern Indian History, which can be further categorized into Historiography, Sultanate period, Mughal period, British period. The course also includes History of Modern West, Modern Europe, History of South East Asia, History of USA, History of USSR, Ancient World Civilization. To give the students an insight into the regional history the course includes the history of Assam of different periods.

# Course outcome:

The main focus in History course at UG level is on the stages of growth of human civilization and the evolution of society and social system throughout the cultural and scientific development. It is the study of the society as a whole and the evolution throughout the ages. Knowledge of History makes a person aware of his own socio cultural identity. It is the understanding of the process of change with the present stage of development. It promotes the understanding of common routes of human civilization. With the study of contemporary history one can easily compromise with the situation and obviously the past knowledge has paved the way for a man to understand his necessity and urge of the society.

# **Department of Political Science**

# **Programme Outcome:**

It looks at how economic activity and policy affect the environment in which we live.

Paper 5.4 & 6.4 : International Economics :

It helps in assessing economic and political effects and the implication to the international trade for goods and services, finance and foreign investment.

It imparts the policy of Indian govt.

Paper 5.6 & 6.6 : History of economic thought :

It helps us to understand the origin of economics and to avoid the mistakes committed by earlier economic thinkers.
