

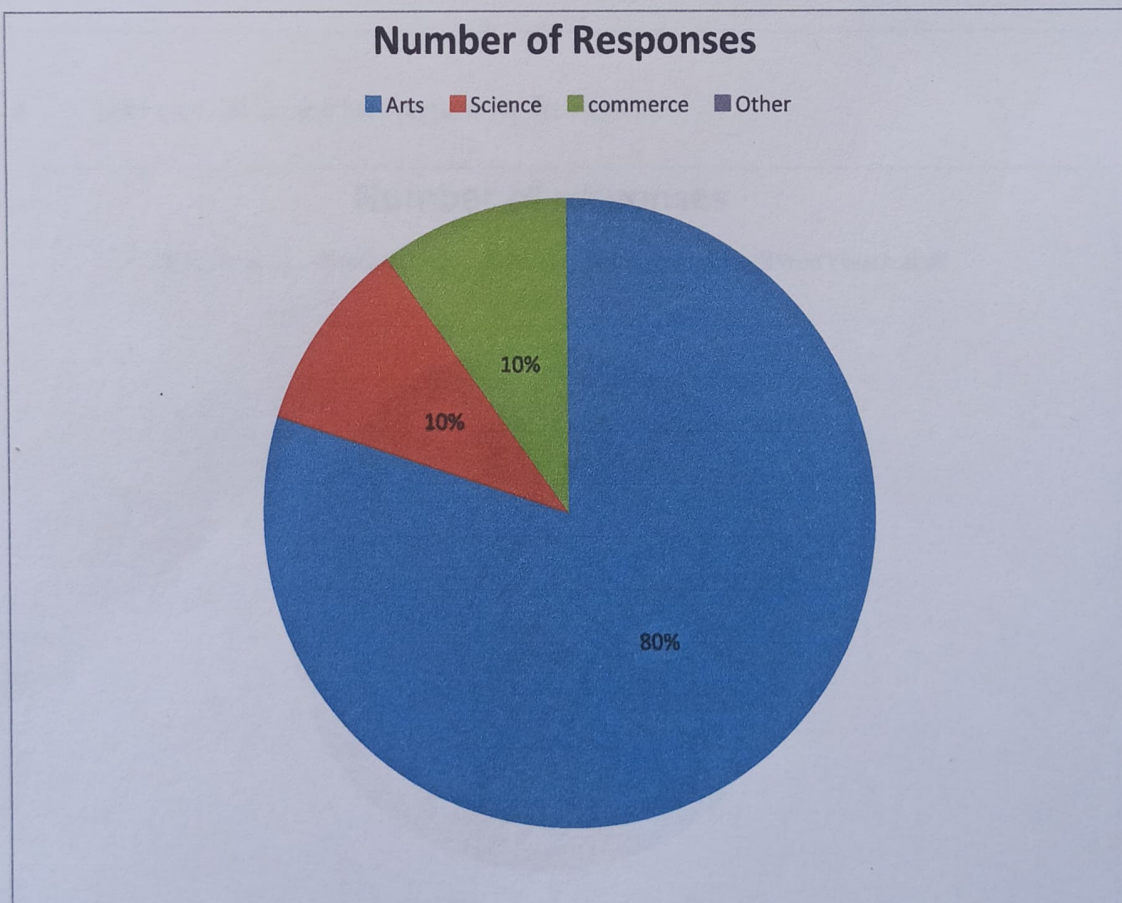
STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT

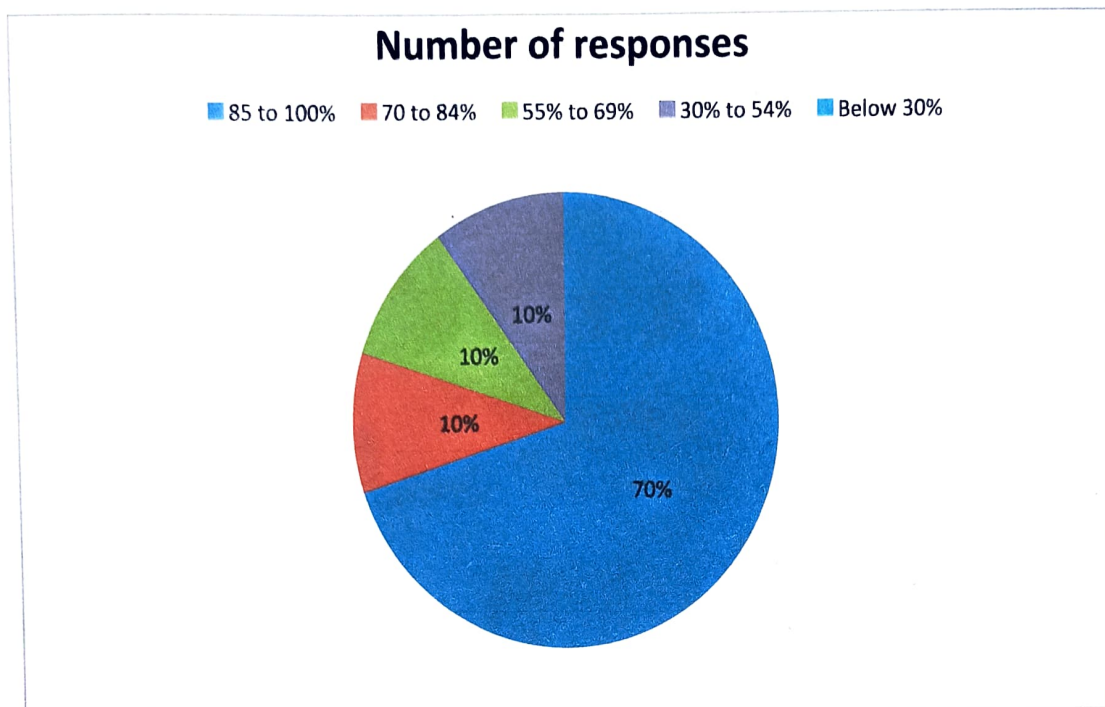
GORESWAR: 2017-18
